



### Update 27 March, 2026

Following the recent poll where all members had the opportunity to vote on 3 important topics, this announcement attempts to clarify some points regarding Vote number 1. The vote stated that the measure is intended to protect the YEM ecosystem from large-scale fraudulent transfers and ensure the stability of our currency and was as follows:

Do you agree that the YEM Foundation, in cooperation with Unicorn Network, can set a limit on the amount of YEM that can be transferred out of YEM Wallets each month to prevent the massive abuse currently taking place?

**The results were clear with 97.84%**

For clarification regarding the monthly limits that are currently set on YEM transfers.

1. The limits are per month and that is a calendar month.
2. The limits are reset at midnight on the last day of every month.
3. The limits only apply when transferring YEM to the escrow of the DEC; the Digital Exchange Center.
4. DINGO now also has the same functionality of the DEC, so the allowance is shared on both those platforms. There is not a separate monthly limit for each one.
5. The monthly limit is 100,000 YEM
6. The limits will be reviewed and assessed as and when needed and be communicated to YEM holders on Social Media Channels.
7. All other transfers, purchases of Swiss Digital programs, conversions of other tokens to YEM etc. etc. are not affected.
